Tire Clearance Measurement

- Remove the air cap and depress the air valve to deflate the fork. (For coil forks, refer to the fork service manual for spring removal and installation)
- Compress the fork to bottom out. You may need to depress the air valve again to remove any remaining air from the fork to achieve bottom out.
- Measure the space between the top of the tire and the bottom of the fork crown.


MWARNING

There must be a minimum of 6 mm between the top of the tire and the fork crown and the side of the tire and the lower leg when the fork is in the bottom out position and the tire is fully inflated.
